

Marshal's Report
May 8th through June 11, 2008

- May 15th-** The Marshal's Office spent the day at the firearms range for semi-annual pistol qualifications. Deputy Payne shot the high score and was awarded lunch and gloating rights by his fellow officers.
- May 22nd-** The Alta Justice Court held its monthly trial and arraignment calender. A male with a lengthy record of violating the Judge's orders regarding alcohol/driving violations was sentenced to an immediate jail term. He was transported from the court to begin his sentence at the Salt Lake County Jail.
- June 1st-** Just after 2:00 a.m., a resident called to report a commotion being caused by the occupants of a vehicle that had become stuck on the Albion Summer Road. Two males, an adult and a juvenile had driven past the road closed sign and gotten their car hopelessly stranded in a snow drift. They then proceeded to the cat shop and began rummaging through vehicles looking for keys so they could pull themselves free. Not surprisingly, it appears that alcohol was involved. Charges are pending.
- At 9:04 a.m., a residential alarm was investigated at a Bypass road residence.
- June 5th-** At 8:50 a.m. an off duty Alta Deputy discovered a vehicle that driven off the road in the seven turns area of the canyon. The driver apparently done so intentionally and was also found to be suffering from self-inflicted knife wounds. The driver was flown to a local hospital in serious condition.
- June 7th-** At 10:46 a.m., the Alta Town Clerk witnessed another car that had driven off the highway in the Lisa Falls area. This time, two males who had been freebasing cocaine and who were running from the invisible cops that had been chasing them for days, decided to intentionally crash their vehicle. The men were extremely uncooperative with officers, cutting themselves with broken glass and attempting to throw blood at rescuers. A taser was deployed and the men were attended to by medical personnel. Both were transported to a hospital.
