A RESOLUTION EXTENDING ALL TEMPORARY DOG LICENSES

WHEREAS, the Town Council is considering changes to the Animal Control provisions of the Alta Town Code;

WHEREAS, the changes being considered may affect who qualifies for temporary dog licenses and the term of temporary dog licenses;

WHEREAS, absent action by the Mayor, several temporary dog licenses will expire on May 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council's deliberations regarding changes to the Animal Control provisions of the Alta Town Code will likely extend into May 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It is in the best interests of the Town to maintain the status quo while the Town Council considers changes to the Animal Control provisions of the Alta Town Code.

Section 2. To preserve the status quo, the expiration date of all currently valid temporary dog licenses shall be June 1, 2018.
