**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-R-2**

**A RESOLUTION EXTENDING ALL TEMPORARY DOG LICENSES**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council is considering changes to the Animal Control provisions of the Alta Town Code;

**WHEREAS**, the changes being considered may affect who qualifies for temporary dog licenses and the term of temporary dog licenses;

**WHEREAS**, absent action by the Mayor, several temporary dog licenses will expire on May 1, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council's deliberations regarding changes to the Animal Control provisions of the Alta Town Code will likely extend into May 2018.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** It is in the best interests of the Town to maintain the status quo while the Town Council considers changes to the Animal Control provisions of the Alta Town Code.

**Section 2.** To preserve the status quo, the expiration date of all currently valid temporary dog licenses shall be June 1, 2018.
