







Chapter 12
OFF STREET PARKING REQUIREMENTS

10-12-6: MAINTENANCE AND DEVELOPMENT OF PARKING AREAS:

C. Lighting: The lighting of parking areas shall be so designed to allow the safe use of facilities by both vehicles and pedestrians at all times. Parking area lighting shall not direct or reflect light to adjacent uses or roads. The final design, including the selection of lighting fixtures, shall be approved by the planning commission acting on the recommendation of the technical review committee.

Chapter 13 SIGN REQUIREMENTS

10-13-13: LIGHTED SIGNS:

- A. A lighted sign shall not be installed which permits the light to penetrate beyond the property in such a manner as to annoy or interfere with the use of adjacent properties.
- B. Such lights alleged to violate the above by the adjacent property owners or building official shall be subject to a public hearing before the planning commission as to the validity of the alleged violation. If such light is determined to be in violation, the owner of said light shall take appropriate corrective action as directed.
