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### Background

The Town of Alta participated in a project led by Salt Lake County Emergency Management updating its Hazard Mitigation Plan in 2019. All Salt Lake County municipalities created their own annex to the county plan, including Alta. Staff presented the Alta Town Council with the key component of the Town of Alta Annex, a table of hazard mitigation actions, at the December, 2019 meeting and requested input on the table. Salt Lake County submitted its complete plan including the Alta annex to the U.S. Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in late 2019, and FEMA approved the county plan earlier in 2020.

### Action Required

Salt Lake County is asking all municipalities in the county to adopt the full 2019 Salt Lake County Hazard Mitigation Plan. Municipalities become eligible for certain types of mitigation project and disaster relief funding by adopting the plan.
