# RECENT HISTORY

- Developed new strategic approach following pandemic budget cuts, loss of coordinator
  - "enhance the Alta experience for locals and visitors"
  - New programming including support for A.C.E. public art and placemaking programming
- ACVB board has operated organization since 2020

#### PROGRAM AREAS

- Destination Marketing
- Community-Guided Visitor Information
- Member Services
- Public Art and Placemaking

### What Works

- 2x annual ACVB member events are well attended business community gatherings convened by a non-profit entity
- ACVB Support for Alta Resort/Town Shuttle Programs
  - Working with Visit Salt Lake to receive night shuttle contributions
  - Applying to Utah Office Tourism Grant to support shuttle (unsuccessful)
  - Facilitating contributions by local partners
  - Making one-time contributions to close funding gaps
- ACVB Relationship with A.C.E.
  - Provides ACVB initiatives local credibility and visibility
  - Enhances funding available for A.C.E. programs



### What Doesn't Work

Persistent ACVB challenges of past and present:

- Board and member recruitment is challenging, static
- ACVB budget and program planning continues to underachieve
  - Routinely underspend budget, growing balance of funds on-hand
- Low return on investment for destination marketing initiatives
- Recent application to UOT grant for shuttle funding
  - Very time consuming, not successful
- Is ACVB a good use of public funds, member contributions?



## Dissolution or Dormancy?

Board of Directors is exploring the possibility of dissolving ACVB

- Dormancy would require continued board activity, some overhead expenses
  - Will ACVB ever have enough resources to retain an employee?
- ACVB maintains \$84,000 checking account balance
  - Bylaws require assets to transferred to another 501(c)6, but...
  - ACVB has not collected member dues or TOA contribution in FY 23
- Can we ensure successful elements live on?
  - Community gatherings, A.C.E. support
- Dissolution requires written consent of 2/3 of active ACVB members
  - Will discuss with membership at 4/18 member event



#### Request for Town Council Input

#### ACVB is a Town of Alta program

- TOA staff have served as Town's board representative for many years
  - Staff is seeking council input on the board's direction
- ACVB Appears in the budget document as the Town's "Economic Development" department
  - TOA contribution to ACVB was originally enabled by a sales tax increase in ~2005
  - Contribution was \$84,000 plus additional \$5-\$10K for grant match, reduced to \$42,000 during pandemic, reduced to \$31,500 in FY 23
- Can ACVB operate the Resort Shuttle program?
  - Yes, but would require additional overhead, board coordination, could still entail a lot of work for the Town
