## Section 1

Select the appropriate Category for your business.

Subsection 1A - REQUIRED for Cat 1, 2, and 3 applications

- Subsection 1A Definitions:
  - Standard lodging units: means each bedroom in a hotel, a motel, a bed and breakfast establishment or an inn. It
    also means each bedroom in a condominium or property used as a residence that is part of a rental pool or
    regularly rented out for a time period of less than 30 consecutive days.
  - High-occupancy lodging units: means each bedroom in a hostel or a unit similar to a hostel. A hostel is a supervised, inexpensive lodging place for travelers, especially young travelers.

Second App: Applicable to any entity applying for more than one business license in the same category.

### Section 2

Select either New Application or Renewal.

State Entity #: For approval from the Town of Alta, your business must also be registered with the State of Utah. If you do not know your State Entity #, you can search for your business and find the number via this link: https://secure.utah.gov/bes/index.html

**State Sales Tax #:** This is the number you use to file taxes with the Utah State Tax Commission, obtained by filling out form TC-69. Most often, an 11 digit number with a hyphen separating the final 3 numbers with STC at the end (xxxxxxx-xxx STC).

If you are operating a short-term rental, you may not need to have your own unique State Sales Tax # unless you rent directly. Please write-in the name of your Property Management Company (examples: Airbnb, Canyon Services, Alta Chalets, etc.)

### Section 3

Business Address: Physical location of your business in Alta. Mailing Address: Preferred mailing address for your business license to be sent to. Business Description: The nature of the commercial or professional activity you are applying for.

### Section 4

Sole Proprietorship: An unincorporated business that has just one owner who pays personal income tax on profits earned from the business.

Partnership: A formal arrangement by two or more parties to manage and operate a business and share its profits. LLC: A business structure that protects its owners from personal responsibility for its debts or liabilities. Corporation: A legal entity that is separate and distinct from its owners.
