A Class " $D$ " private club is any other club that does not qualify as a class " $A$ ", " $B$ ", or " $C$ " private club and that does less than $50 \%$ of its business on the sale of food.

Licensed to sell liquor, wine, and beer in open containers and on draft for on premise consumption. May sell beer in sealed containers, in any size not exceeding two liters, to go. Any employee handling alcoholic beverages must be 21years of age or older, wear an identification badge, and must take and pass an alcohol server training seminar every three years.

Alcoholic beverages may be sold on any day from 10:00 AM until 1:00 AM. On election days, liquor may not be sold until after the polls are closed.

Clubs must offer a variety of food prepared and served in connection with dining accommodations. Food must beavailable at all times when alcohol is sold, served, or consumed.
